The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for seeking grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case bearing FIR No.136, dated 25.11.2021 registered under Sections 408 and 420 of the IPC (Section 406 of the IPC added later on) at Police Station Sadar Raikot, District Ludhiana (Rural).

On 17.02.2023 while issuing notice of motion, the petitioner was directed to join the investigation.

Today on resumed hearing, learned State Counsel, on instructions from ASI Kewal Singh, informs that pursuant to the order dated 17.02.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation and as of now, he is not required for any further custodial interrogation/investigation.
