The petitioner through instant petition, on the basis of compromise dated 25.02.2021 (Annexure P-3), is seeking quashing of FIR No. 276 dated 20.9.2020, under Section 365 of IPC (challan filed under Sections 365, 376, 506, 201 of IPC, Section 3(2)(v) of SC and ST Act and Section 67 of Information Technology Act), registered at Police Station, Nissing, District Karnal and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom.

Learned counsel for the petitioner inter alia contends that complainant and prosecutrix stand examined and they have turned hostile. The parties have entered into compromise.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from HC Kuldeep, submits that there are total 27 prosecution witnesses and almost all material witnesses stand examined. The next date before trial court is 31.3.2023.

Without commenting upon merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a request to the trial court to expedite the trial especially in view of compromise between the parties and proviso to Section 309 Cr.P.C.
