TEJINDER SINGH DHINDSA, J. (ORAL)

We have heard counsel for the parties.

Since an advance copy had already been served upon the creditor/Union Bank of India, Mr. Gaurav Goel, Advocate has entered appearance on behalf of respondent No.1.

During the course of hearing today, the Court has been apprised that the total outstanding in both; the term loan account and credit card is approximately Rs.91,000/-.

Counsel representing the petitioners undertakes to clear the entire outstanding amount but seeks indulgence of this court for some reasonable time to be granted for such purpose.

Counsel for the Bank very fairly states that a period of 04 weeks, if granted, would be acceptable to the Bank.

Undertaking of the counsel for the petitioners is recorded to the effect that a sum of Rs.30,000/- would be deposited positively by 20.02.2023 and the balance amount would be deposited by 31.03.2023.

In the light of such undertaking, writ petition is disposed of.

However, we direct that the auction which is slated for 20.02.2023 may proceed but sale would not be confirmed till 31.03.2023 and would be subject to the petitioners making good the undertaking that has been furnished today.
