The present petition has been filed for issuance of directions to the respondents to fill up the vacant posts of BC-A and BC-B categories, from the list of candidates of General Category, in view of the reservation policy dated 15.07.2014 (Annexure P-4).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in pursuance of the advertisement No.6 dated 20.07.2006, the petitioners applied for the post of Physical Training Instructors (PTIs); that the petitioner appeared for the written examination conducted by the respondents; that roll numbers of the petitioners were shown in the waiting list; that the posts reserved for the candidates of BC-A and BC-B Categories are still lying vacant, and that the letter dated 15.07.2014 issued by the General Administration Department, Haryana, specifically provides that in case two attempts of recruitment fail to get eligible candidates under the reserved categories except for the Scheduled Castes Category, the aforesaid posts shall be de-

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reserved and would be filled up in the subsequent recruitment process from the candidates of general category, and that Classical and Vernacular (C & V) teacher is a dying cadre and no further recruitment for the post of PTI is to be made under the aforesaid category.

Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that the petitioners had already raised the said grievance before the respondents by way of filing a representation dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-6), which is still pending consideration and the petitioners will be satisfied in case a time bound direction is issued to respondent No.3 to decide the said representation.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of this Court, Mr. R.S.Budhwar, Addl. A.G. Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order.

In view of the request made by the learned counsel for the petitioners during the course of hearing, but without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, respondent No.3 is directed to decide the representation dated 17.01.2023 (Annexure P-6) by passing a speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
