The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.07 dated 19.01.2022 registered under Sections 61 and 78(2) of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 and (Section 473 of IPC, 1860 added later on) at Police Station Sadar Patiala, District Patiala.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 07.03.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

The learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Inderjit Singh admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation in the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 07.03.2022 is made absolute. However, the petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and she shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
