DEEPAK MANCHANDA J. (ORAL)

This petition has been filed by the petitioners under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking protection of their lives and personal liberty, from private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that both the petitioners are major, aged 20 years and 24 years respectively and have performed marriage against the wishes of their parents which was solemnized on 14.02.2023. In support thereof, copies of Aadhaar Cards pertaining to the petitioners (Annexures P-1 and P-2) and marriage certificate (Annexure P-3) have also been appended.

It is further submitted that a representation dated 14.02.2023 (Annexure P-4) has also been sent by the petitioners to the respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Batala, which has not been taken into consideration, in spite of being threatened by private respondents.

Notice of motion.

Pursuant to supply of advance copy, Mr. Mohit Kapoor, Addl. AG Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3 and Mr. Harsh Chopra, Advocate has put in appearance, filed his memo of appearance and accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos. 4 to 6, who are parents and brother of petitioner No. 1 and submits that respondent Nos. 4 to 6 have accepted the marriage of the petitioners and they have no grouse against them. He further

submits that respondent Nos. 7 to 9 are the tenants of respondent Nos. 4 to 6 and have nothing to do with the present petition.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for respondent Nos. 4 to 6, nothing remains to be adjudicated in the present petition.

Thus, the present petition is disposed of with no order.
