AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

This is the fourth petition seeking regular bail in FIR No. 114 dated 10.7.2019, under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Sangrur.

Reply filed on behalf of the State is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that the case is fixed for recording the statement of the accused under Section 313 Cr.P.C.

In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the State, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition at this stage. However, he requests that the court below be directed to conclude the trial expeditiously.
