This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release an amount of Rs.11,22,270, being the amount due to petitioner No.2 under the scheme of Community Development through Polytechnic (CDTP) for the years 2019-20, 2020-21 and 2021-22.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that petitioner No.1, for the redressal of his grievance, has given a representation dated 19.10.2022 (Annexure P-9) to Director General, Ministry of Skill Development & Entrepreneurship, Government of India

(respondent No.1) and would be satisfied in case respondent No.1 is directed to look into the said representation (P-9) and to take a final decision on the same, in accordance with law.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of respondent No.1- UOI has submitted that every endeavour would be made by respondent No.1 to take a final decision on the representation dated 19.10.2022 (Annexure P-9), as expeditiously as possible.

Keeping in view the above-said facts and circumstances, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the representation dated 19.10.2022 (Annexure P-9), in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

It is made clear that this Court has not opined on the merits of the case and respondent No.1 would consider the said representation independently in accordance with law.
