1. By way of present revision petition filed under Article 227 of the Constitution of India, challenge has been made to an order dated 03.12.2020, passed by the Collector Land Acquisition, Department of Industries and Commerce, Punjab, thereby, dismissing the petition filed under Section 28-A of the Land Acquisition Act, 1894 (for short, "Act").
2. Learned State counsel submits that the order passed under Section 28-A of the Act, is assailable under sub-section 3 of Section 28-A of the Act.
3. In view thereof, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for withdrawal of the present petition with a liberty to avail alternate remedy in accordance with law, especially, provided under sub-section 3 of Section 28-A of the Act.
4. In view of the above, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as prayed for.
