Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not challenging the impugned order dated 16.11.2022 (Annexure P-1) on merits but the opinion recorded in paragraph 11 of the impugned order is going to cause prejudice to the petitioner as the main petition is yet to be decided.

Qua the apprehension raised that observations made in the impugned order will hurt the petitioner during the conduct of the trial, same is not correct to be ascertained. The claim of the petitioner will be decided on merits and any observation made in the said interim order, will not override the facts and evidence, which will come on record, which will only be the basis for deciding the dispute between the parties.

Keeping in view the above, as prayed for, the present petition is disposed of having been not pressed.
