1. Prayer made in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is for execution of the order dated 15.06.2022 (Annexure P-3) against the private respondents under Section 14 of the Securitization and Reconstruction of Financial Assets and Enforcement of Security Interest Act, 2002 (in short 'the Act').

2. Private respondent Nos.6 to 8 have chosen not to file reply though they had put in appearance on 27.02.2023.

3. A perusal of the possession notice dated 09.03.2022 (Annexure P-2) would go on to show that the outstandings are Rs.26,15,251.06/- as on 01.04.2021.

4. Resultantly, the present writ petition stands disposed of with direction to the official respondents to ensure compliance of the order passed by the District Magistrate on 15.06.2022 (Annexure P-3) within a period of 4 weeks, keeping in view the law laid down in ***Allahabad Bank vs. District***

Magistrate, Ludhiana and others, 2021 (4) RCR (Civil) 571. Status report

be submitted to the Registrar General thereafter within 2 weeks. It is made

clear that it is open to the private respondents to take recourse to their remedy under Section 17 of the Act against Section 13(4) proceedings, if they so desire.
