Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to release incentive, for working during Covid-19.

Counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner was working as Dental Surgeon when he was directed to conduct sampling duty during Covid-19. By referring to the Haryana Government Notifications Annexure P-1 and P-2, counsel for the petitioner submits that the government decided to give an incentive to the staff who were deployed on during during Covid-19, but, nothing has been paid to the petitioner. Counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner has served legal notice dated 19.07.2022 Annexure P-9 upon respondents No. 1 to 5, but to no avail. He further submits that the petitioner will be satisfied in case a direction is issued to the respondents to look into the legal notice Annexure P-9.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. R.K.S. Brar, Addl. A.G., Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call upon the respondents to file a response.

Having heard counsel for the parties, but without commenting upon the averments made in the writ petition, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Director General Health, Sector-6, Panchkula to examine the legal notice Annexure P-9 within a period of 04 months from the date of communication of this order. In case, the respondent concerned comes to the conclusion that the claim cannot be granted, an order shall be passed by him assigning reasons in support thereof.
