Prayer in this petition is for cancellation of bail granted to
respondent No.2 by this Court vide order dated 15.12.2020 passed in CRM-M-
35054-2020, in FIR No.52 dated 21.02.2020 under Sections 363, 366 IPC and
Section 6 of POCSO, registered at Police Station Dhauj, District Faridabad.

Allegations in the petition are that subsequent to grant of regular bail, calendra under Sections 107/150 Cr.P.C. was initiated against respondent No.2 on 07.01.2021 and some publication was made on social media platform.

Learned counsel for respondent No.2 submits that calendra under Sections 107/150 Cr.P.C. has already been closed vide Annexure R-2/14 and with regard to FIR itself, the trial has been stayed vide order dated 09.02.2023 passed in CRR-2832-2022 filed by respondent No.2 against framing of charge. It is further submitted that respondent No.2 is regularly appearing before the trial Court and some of the witnesses have already been examined and it is not noticed by the trial Court that the petitioner has extended any threat to the witnesses or has tried to influence them.

In view of the above, no ground for cancellation of bail granted to respondent No.2 is made out at this stage.

Accordingly, present petition is dismissed.
