This appeal has been filed by the appellant-husband, challenging decision dated 19.01.2022, passed by learned Family Court, Sangrur, whereby in the petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, respondent-wife had withdrawn her consent. Petition was accordingly dismissed as withdrawn.

During pendency of this appeal, matter was yet again settled amicably between the parties and following order was passed on the last date of hearing:-

“Learned counsel for the appellant wishes to withdraw the present appeal as the settlement agreement dated 02.06.2022 in the petition under Section 13 (B) of the Hindu Marriage Act has been filed in Sangrur.

Learned counsel appearing for the respondent states that the second motion of the petition is fixed in the month of January, 2023. She seeks time to complete her instructions.

Adjourned to 28.02.2023.”

Learned counsel for the respondent affirms and verifies that decree of divorce has been granted by the learned Family Court, Sangrur, therefore, this appeal is rendered infructuous.

Appeal is disposed of accordingly.
