The petitioner herein has sought the relief of anticipatory/
pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.111
dated 27.05.2022 as registered at Police Station Phase-1, SAS Nagar
(Mohali), under Sections 323, 506, 406 and 498-A IPC.

2. Today, learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI
Dilbagh Singh from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court
that in compliance of the order passed by the Co-ordinate Bench on
20.02.2023, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial
interrogation is not required and he is also not involved in any other
criminal case.

3. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as already extended to the petitioner by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 20.02.2023, is hereby made absolute.

4. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
