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As agreed, as per statements of learned counsel for the appellants as well as counsel for the Insurance Company, separately recorded, a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal, is awarded to the appellants. Learned counsel further submitted that appellant No.1 has since died. Her LR's (appellants 2 to 4) are already on record and thus, the entire enhanced amount be paid to appellants 2 to 4 in equal shares, in full & final satisfaction of the claim.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the Insurance Company to pay through cheque(s) a sum of Rs.5,00,000/- in equal shares favouring appellant No.2-Dalip Kumar, appellant No.3-Parmod Kumar and appellant No.4-Devi Chand with the Office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 11.03.2023. Failing compliance of the order, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount till payment from the date of this order. The appellants' counsel may collect the cheque(s)/draft(s) from the office of the Lok Adalat. The office shall retain the photocopy of the cheque(s)/draft(s) bearing signatures of the Counsel.

Appeal stands disposed of.
