This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of an appropriate writ in the nature of mandamus to direct respondent no.1 to take action on the representation dated 18.01.2017 (Annexure P-2) filed by the petitioner against the impugned order dated 23.12.2002 passed by the Superintendent of Police, Jhajjar whereby the petitioner was dismissed from the service on the ground of being absent from duty.

2. On 28.07.2022, this Court was pleased to pass the following order:-
