Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India inter alia for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari quashing the impugned gradation list of Prisons Department Haryana, Annexure P-8 as on 01.01.2019 to the extent the name of the petitioner has been placed below the private respondents. Another prayer has been made for directing the respondents to correct the gradation list and to take into consideration the objections submitted by the petitioner on 07.01.2022, Annexure P-5.

Grievance of the petitioner is that he has submitted objections, Annexure P-5, to the gradation list of Officers of Haryana Prisons Service (Class-II) pursuant to letter dated 04.01.2022, Annexure P-4, but the same has not been decided despite a lapse of more than one year.

Counsel submits that the petitioners will be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to examine the objections.

Notice of motion confined to respondents No.1 and 2 only at this stage.

On asking of the Court, Mr. R.K.S.Brar, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

Given the nature of order being passed, this Court does not deem it necessary to call for a return from the respondents.

Without examining the grievance of the petitioner, writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to examine the objections, submitted by the petitioner, Annexure P-5, within a period of four months from the date of communication of this order.
