1. The petitioner has filed the instant revision petition challenging the order dated 22.10.2020 passed by learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Karnal whereby application filed by the petitioner under Order 39 Rule 1 and 2 of CPC has been dismissed as well as order dated 06.10.2021 passed by learned District Judge, Karnal whereby an appeal filed by the petitioner against order dated 22.10.2020 has also been dismissed.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time on 04.04.2022 for placing on record a copy of sale deed and the case was adjourned to 26.07.2022. Thereafter, the case has been adjourned repeatedly vide orders dated 26.07.2022, 14.11.2022, 16.01.2023, 26.04.2023 and 17.07.2023 on the request of learned counsel for the petitioner for compliance of the order dated 04.04.2022. Today also the

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same request has been made. There is no justification for grant of adjournment as more than a period of one year and six months have passed and the order dated 04.04.2022 has not been complied with as yet.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner wishes to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh one on the same cause of action with better particulars, by attaching the copy of sale deed.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid.
