Prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in a case bearing FIR No.250 dated 23.10.2021 under Sections 323, 324, 341, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code (Section 326 of IPC added later on) registered at Police Station City Phagwara, District Kapurthala.

Vide order dated 07.03.2022 while granting interim protection, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that pursuant to order dated 07.03.2022, petitioner has joined the investigation and as such his interim bail may be made absolute. The learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI- Gurvinder Pal Singh has affirmed the fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and his further investigation in the present case is not required.

In view of the above, interim order dated 07.03.2022 is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The present petition stands disposed off.
