1. Present transfer application, under Section 24 CPC, has been filed by the petitioner-wife, for seeking transfer of the petition, bearing No. DMC/938/2020, filed by the respondent–husband, under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955, titled as “Balwinder Singh Vs. Simarpreet Chahal”, presently pending in the Court of Learned
