AMAN CHAUDHARY. J.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 482 CrPC for issuance of directions to respondent No.2 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and further restraining the respondent Nos.4 to 8 from harassing the petitioner as well as GPA of the petitioner and to conduct fair, impartial and expeditious investigation of the case.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.2 to decide his representation dated 05.10.2018 (Annexure P-6) submitted by him.

3. Learned State counsel has no objection to the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioner.

4. In view of the limited prayer made by the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the case, this petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 to look into the representation of the petitioner dated

05.10.2018 (Annexure P-6) and decide the same expeditiously, in accordance with law.

5. It is however, made clear that this order shall not preclude the authorities to proceed against the petitioner, in case, he is found involved in any other civil or criminal proceedings, instituted/ pending against him or pass any order if there is some evidence that surfaces regarding his involvement in a cognizable offence, for which he may be required by the investigating agency.
