This is a Civil Writ Petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 16.05.2002 passed by the Financial Commissioner, Appeals-I, Punjab, Chandigarh, vide which, the orders of the authorities were set aside and the matter was remanded back to the Assistant Collector, Ist Grade, for fresh decision.
