The petitioners are seeking quashing of FIR No.37 dated 06.03.2012 under Sections 148, 149, 427, 447, 448, 506 and 511 of the IPC registered at Police Station Kharar, District SAS Nagar, Mohali and order dated 03.04.2014 vide which they were declared proclaimed offenders.

Learned counsel for the petitioners at the outset submits that he would not press the quashing of the FIR in question, however, he submits that the petitioners are willing to appear and surrender before the Trial Court and they may be protected till such time with directions to the Trial Court that their bail application, which they would be filing on their surrender, be decided expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Ramdeep Partap Singh, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

In view of the limited prayer made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of with directions to the petitioners to appear and surrender before the Trial Court within 10

days from today. Till then, no coercive steps be taken against the petitioners.

It is made clear that in case, the petitioners fail to surrender before the Trial Court within 10 days from today, this order shall be of no avail to them. In case, on appearance and surrender, the petitioners move an application for bail before the Trial Court, the same shall be decided expeditiously by the Trial Court in accordance with law.
