On the last date of hearing, following order was passed:

“Serious allegations of kidnapping the minor and asking for ransom were made as per the allegations made in the FIR, which is now sought to be quashed on the basis of compromise. Although statement of parties have been recorded but it is to be determined by the Court whether considering the nature of allegations, quashing on the basis of compromise can be allowed.

Learned counsel for the petitioners seeks time to show the necessary case law in this regard.

Adjourned to 19.05.2023.”

Considering the fact that today nobody is making appearance on behalf of petitioner or respondent No.2, it is evident that they are not in a position to convince this Court that quashing of FIR on basis of compromise can be ordered considering the nature of allegations.

Dismissed for want of prosecution.
