Prayer made in the present petition was for seeking
issuance of directions to the respondents to make due payment of Rs.
94,43,058/- qua the works of Desilting of Sewer Lines and Manholes
by hiring Super Sucker Machines, executed by the petitioner.

Counsel for the petitioner has referred to the status report
filed by the Commissioner, Municipal Corporation, Faridabad and the
inquiry report dated 04.05.2023 appended alongwith. As per the
averments contained in the said enquiry report, the respondents
acknowledged that the pending liability of 22 bills to the tune as claimed
have been verified from the record of the Accounts Branch alongwith

the name of work, ward/sector, bill/cash memo and the MBs have been marked, however, it is submitted that the payment of the said bills/vouchers could not be made since there was a fire and the original bills/vouchers have been destroyed.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the Municipal Corporation, Faridabad, on instructions from the Sh. Ombir, Superintending Engineer, submits that the bills shall be regenerated within period of 02 months from today and that the undisputed payment in terms of the approved vouchers shall be released in favour of the petitioner within a period of two months thereafter.

In view of the above statement, counsel for the petitioner does not press the present writ petition at this stage.

The petition is accordingly disposed of as not pressed at this stage.

The respondents shall, however, remain bound by the statement made in the Court.

All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of.
