The present petitioner has filed the present petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus to direct the respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner. A further prayer has been made to direct the respondent No.2 to decide the representation dated 05.02.2023, submitted to DGP, Punjab.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that as per the reply submitted by the State of Punjab, one FIR No.96 dated 02.04.2022, under Section 346 of Indian Penal Code, Police Station Gobindgarh Mandi, District Fatehgarh Sahib has been registered in a complaint made by Ms. Usha wife of Jagdish Lal and he shall be satisfied in case appropriate directions are issued to the State of Punjab to investigate the said FIR at the earliest and in accordance with law.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Harminder Singh, submits that the investigation in the FIR No.346/22 is being conducted by ASI Harminder Singh and the investigation in the said case shall be concluded within a period of 4 months from today.

In view of faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner does not press the present petition, at this stage.

Dismissed as not pressed, at this stage.
