On 10.03.2023, following order was passed by this Court:-

CRM No.11130 of 2023

This is an application to place on record documents Annexures P.7 to P.16 which are being filed in compliance of the order dated 01.03.2023.

Application is allowed. Annexures P.7 to P.16 are taken on record.

CRM-M-10587 of 2023

Learned counsel for the petitioner has pointed out that in the compliant (Annexure P.16) filed by the respondent, the name of accused has not been mentioned, rather accused has been referred as "Planet Bulls Consultants Pvt. Ltd. through its authorized signatory".

Attention is then drawn towards various orders Annexures P.7 to P.15 in order to contend that petitioner was never served even once. Even the proclamation was not effected as per law inasmuch as vide order dated 16.07.2022 (Annexure P.15) proclamation was ordered to be effected for 12.09.2022 but petitioner has been declared proclaimed person vide order dated 12.10.2022, though no proclamation had been issued for that date i.e. 12.10.2022.

Notice of motion for 17.04.2023.

In the meantime, petitioner is directed to surrender before the trial Court within 15 days from today. On his such appearance, trial Court shall admit him to bail to its own satisfaction. If, in the

meantime, petitioner is sought to be arrested pursuant to the proclamation issued against him then he shall be admitted to bail to the satisfaction of the Arresting Officer.”

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner has placed on record the copy of the order dated 25.03.2023 passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kurukshetra, to contend that he has already surrendered before the Trial Court and was granted bail.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter has since been withdrawn on the basis of compromise effected amongst the parties. No further action is required.

Having regard to the reasons as mentioned in the order dated 10.03.2023 and considering the fact that the main case itself stands compromised as stated by learned counsel for the petitioner, the impugned order dated 12.10.2022 (Annexure P-1) passed by learned Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, Kurukshetra in NACT/826/2020 and all the subsequent proceedings arising therefrom are hereby quashed.
