1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 seeking quashing of FIR No.0081 dated 14.07.2018, registered for offences under Sections 420 and 406 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, at Police Station Kot Ise Khan, District Moga, Annexure P-1, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of the panchayati compromise dated 20.10.2018, Annexure P-2, arrived at between the parties.

2. On 13.07.2023, this Court passed the following order:-

“The present petition has been filed for quashing of the FIR in question on the basis of compromise.

As per the office report, respondent No.2 refused to accept the notice.

This Court is of the view that no compromise has been effected between the parties.

In the interest of justice, adjourned to 02.08.2023.”

3. Faced with the same, counsel for the petitioner seeks and is granted permission to withdraw the petition.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn.
