The petitioner is seeking issuance of directions to respondent No. 4 to complete the investigation and submit the final report in the case bearing FIR No. 56 dated 15.07.2020 under Sections 323, 324, 506 and 34 IPC (later on Section 326 IPC was added) registered at Police Station Jodhan, District Ludhiana Rural.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Dalwinder Singh, submits that the dispute between the parties has been amicably settled in terms of the order dated 13.05.2022 passed in CRM-M-6802-2022. The aforesaid FIR has been quashed on the basis of compromise and consequently the present petition has become infructuous.

In view of the categoric assertion made by learned State counsel, the present petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.

However, none has appeared on behalf of the petitioner. He shall be at liberty to move an application for revival of the petition within a period of three months, if the aforesaid assertion of learned State counsel is found to be factually incorrect.
