1. The instant petition has been preferred under Section 482 Cr.P.C for quashing of FIR No. 218, dated 10.12.2017 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 279, 337 and 427 IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri and all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, on the basis of Panchayati compromise dated 04.05.2018 (Annexure P-2).

2. As per report received from the trial Court none of the parties have appeared for recording of the statements.

3. Upon instructions from ASI Gurmail Singh, State counsel has placed on record copy of the order dated 13.07.2019 passed by the Presiding Officer, National Lok Adalat and has submitted that an untraced report presented by the Investigating Agency to which the complainant has given "No Objection", has been accepted by the trial Court.

4. There is no representation on behalf of the private parties.

5. As per report received from the trial Court, the parties have not appeared for recording of their statements. It seems that in view of the order

placed on record by the State counsel, the parties are not interested in pursuing the matter.

6. Dismissed for non-prosecution.
