1. The petitioners are seeking to quash the FIR No.0033 dated 14.07.2019 under Section 498-A IPC and Sections 406 and 34 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Women, Police District Bathinda on the basis of compromise.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners contend that the matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled between the parties in terms of the compromise, Annexure P-2. Respondent No.2 has received a sum of Rs.30 lac on account of permanent alimony and subsequently wriggled out of the compromise.

3. Accordingly, learned counsel for the petitioners seek to withdraw the petition with liberty to avail the alternative remedy as may be available in accordance with law.

4. Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
