Mr. Raj Kumar Arya, Advocate has appeared on behalf of the petitioner and has filed his vakalatnama in the Court today. The same is taken on record. There is no objection from the previous counsel i.e. Mr. Ravi Chadda.

This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C., for quashing of order of proclaimed offender in FIR No.12 dated 23.03.2007 registered at Police Station Purana Shalla, District Gurdaspur, whereby the petitioner has been declared as proclaimed offender vide order dated 03.03.2012.
