Mr. R.S. Khaira, DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Petitioner has prayed for grant of regular bail in case FIR No.90, dated 09.07.2022, registered at Police Station Sadar Malout, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, under Sections 21(b) and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985.

Allegations are that on 09.07.2022, 6 grams of heroin, i.e. of non-commercial quantity, was recovered from co-accused Gagandeep and Gaurav Kumar @ Gora. As per their disclosure statements, the contraband was supplied to them by petitioner Sachin. On that basis, petitioner was arrested in this case under Section 29 of the NDPS Act.

As per custody certificate placed on record by learned State counsel, petitioner is in custody for the last 1 month and 15 days. Co-accused Gagandeep and Gaurav Kumar @ Gora from whom the alleged recovery has been effected, have already been allowed bail. Recovery is of non-commercial quantity. Further investigation and trial may take time to conclude.

Having regard to the aforesaid factual position, but

without commenting anything upon the merits of the case, the petitioner

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is admitted to regular bail and he is ordered to be released on bail on his
furnishing bail bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Trial
Court concerned.
