This is a civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 24.10.2013 passed by respondent no.4, order dated 06.09.2016 passed by respondent no.3 and order dated 11.11.2022 passed by respondent no.2.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since by virtue of the impugned order, the matter has been remanded back to the Assistant Collector Ist Grade for deciding the case afresh, it has been observed by the Financial Commissioner, Appeal, Punjab, Chandigarh that the facts need to be verified at the level of Naib Tehsildar-cum-Assistant Collector Grade-1, Dhariwal and no prejudice has been caused to the petitioner since the matter is remanded, thus, the petitioner limits his prayer

to direction to the Assistant Collector Ist Grade to decide the case after remand as expeditiously as possible.

Keeping in view the prayer made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the Assistant Collector Ist Grade, Dhariwal, to decide the case after remand as expeditiously as possible preferrably within a period of 9 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the present order.
