This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 30.11.2021 (Annexure P-5) passed by respondent No.3 and order dated 02.02.2023 (Annexure P-7) passed by respondent No.1, vide which order dated 16.06.2021 (Annexure P-3) passed by the Collector, SBS Nagar has been set aside.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the caveator has submitted that after the remand of the order by the Commissioner, Rupnagar Division, Rupnagar, the Deputy Commissioner-cum-District Collector, had passed an order dated 20.07.2022, vide which the matter has been further sent to the Court of the SDM, Balachaur, for sending the

recommendation and the said fact has not been mentioned in the present writ petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has prayed that the petitioner be permitted to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to file a fresh petition after giving full and better particulars.

In view of the above statement of learned counsel for the petitioner, the present writ petition is dismissed as withdrawn, with the aforesaid liberty.
