The prayer in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 112, dated 06.05.2022 under Sections 186, 307, 333, 34 IPC and Sections 25, 54, 59 of Arms Act (later Section 120-B, 201, 379, 411 IPC and Section 29-B of Arms Act were also added) registered at Police Station Yamuna Nagar, Haryana.

Vide order dated 24.02.2023, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“As per the allegations, Damandeep @ Vicky made disclosure while he is in custody that he had purchased 11 cartridges for a sum of Rs. 10,000/- from the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the co-accused, namely, Damandeep Singh has already been granted the concession of regular bail vide order dated 20.10.2022 passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge, Yamuna Nagar at Jagadhri.

On asking, learned State counsel has submitted that at this stage, there is no other evidence collected against the petitioner except the disclosure statement.

Meanwhile, in the eventuality of arrest of the petitioner in the instant case, he shall be enlarged on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bond/surety bond to the satisfaction of Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer. The petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

To be heard along with CRM-M No.5025 of 2023.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already joined the investigation and no recovery is to be effected from him.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Raj Kumar submits that in compliance of the order dated 24.02.2023, the petitioner has already joined the investigation and he is not required for any custodial interrogation.

As per allegations, petitioner purchased the cartridges and further supplied the same but no recovery is to be effected from the petitioner.

In view of above, the order dated 24.02.2023 granting interim bail to the petitioner, is made absolute. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions as laid down under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. in letter and spirit.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
