MANJARI NEHRU KAUL, J. (ORAL)

The petitioner is seeking the concession of bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.05 dated 11.01.2023 under Sections 326 (added later on), 323, 324, 506, 148, 149, 452 IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran.

Vide order dated 23.02.2023, the petitioner had been granted concession of interim bail in the following terms:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the case. He, while drawing attention of this Court to the FIR which has been annexed as Annexure P-2, submits that the petitioner was alleged to be armed with datar with which he inflicted an injury on the little finger of the left hand of the complainant and which was opined to be grievous in nature. He further

submits that the petitioner is ready to join investigation and cooperate with the Investigating Agency.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the order dated 23.02.2023, the petitioner has joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, does not dispute the factum of the petitioner having joined investigation and cooperated with the investigating agency. He, on further instructions, submits that the petitioner is not required for further investigation much less for his custodial interrogation.

In the circumstances, the petition is allowed and the interim order dated 23.02.2023 is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Needless to say, in case the petitioner misuses the concession of bail granted to him, the State would be at liberty to seek cancellation of the bail granted to him.
