This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents No.1 and 2 to correct the mother's name of petitioner in matriculation certificates (10th Standard) passed by petitioner in the year 2020 and also to direct respondent No.3 to forward the case of the petitioner to CBSE in accordance with CBSE Bye Laws.

Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since the necessary correction has already been done, thus, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous and the same may be disposed of

as such.
