1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 *inter-alia* seeking quashing of impugned complaint No.420 dated 22.05.2023 titled as “*Tarun Singh Versus Nidhi Tomar and others*”, filed by respondent No.2 under Sections 384, 406, 420 and 506, IPC, Annexure P-1, impugned summoning order dated 18.08.2017, Annexure P-3, passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad, whereby petitioner has been summoned as well as order dated 06.03.2018, Annexure P-5, whereby application of petitioner seeking exemption from personal appearance has been dismissed, along with all subsequent proceedings arising therefrom.

2. Reply by way of an affidavit of Assistant Commissioner of Police, Central, Faridabad has been filed on behalf of State-respondent No.1, which is taken on record.
3. Counsel for the petitioner has placed on record a copy of judgment dated 28.03.2019 passed by the learned Additional Chief Judicial Magistrate, Faridabad, to submit that the trial has concluded and the petitioner has been acquitted. He submits that in view of this development, petition has become infructuous.
4. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
