VIVEK PURI J. (ORAL)

1. Petitioner is seeking to quash the FIR No. 146 dated 27.09.2020 registered under Section 306 of Indian Penal Code at Police Station Payal, District Ludhiana.

2. Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sohan Singh submits that on conclusion of the investigation, challan has been presented, charge has been framed and out of 12 witnesses, only 02 have been examined, during the course of prosecution evidence in the trial Court.

3. Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the present petition with liberty to raise the defence pleas at the appropriate state of trial or assail the order vide which charge has been framed, in accordance with law.

3. In view of the above, present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as aforesaid. .
