Prayer in the present petition was for seeking issuance of directions to the respondents to fix the equal rate for Wheat as well as Rice in Appendix VII-Schedule of Rate for Services of unloading Foodgrains/Wheat bags from wagons/trucks and of storage in the form of sidewall for flat storage upto 10 ft. high.

Counsel for the petitioner contends that in view of the affidavit submitted on behalf of the respondents through Sachin Kataria, Divisional Manager, Food Corporation of India wherein it has been averred that rates has been fixed as per Clause 3 and 30 of Appendix VII of the Schedule for both Wheat and Rice based on operation of activities attached. Since FCI is not operating any modern

Rice Mills and modern tender form Clause 30 is not there, only operations of activities are being done as per Clause 3.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner contends that in view of the aforesaid content of the affidavit filed on behalf of the respondents-FCI, the present writ petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.

All the pending miscellaneous application(s), if any, are also disposed of.
