The instant petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking protection to the life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of the private respondents.

Petitioner No.1 Yes Pal along with his wife and three children i.e. petitioners No.2 to 5, are apprehending threats at the hands of private respondents including his son and daughter-in-law i.e. respondents No.4 and 5, respectively. Learned counsel submits that ever since respondent No.4 solemnized marriage with respondent No.5, the petitioner and his family members are being continuously threatened with dire consequences. It has been further submitted that representation (Annexure P-3) dated 14.02.2023 was also made to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh, however, it had proved to be in vain.

Notice of motion to the official respondents.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Ankur Bali, Addl. PP for UT Chandigarh accepts notice on behalf of the said respondents.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police, Chandigarh to look into the representation (Annexure P-3) dated 14.02.2023 and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents.
