The challenge in the present petition is to the Award dated 11.11.2021 passed by Permanent Lok Adalat (Public Utility Services), Gurugram on an application filed by respondent No.2 under Section 22-C of the Legal Services Authorities Act, 1987.

During the pendency of the present petition, the petitioner herein has already paid the amount in terms of the aforesaid Award.

Learned counsel for the petitioner thus contends that the awarded amount having already been disbursed, he does not press the instant petition to the above extent, however, he has forwarded a request to respondent No.2-applicant to return the original documents relating to the allotment of the flat to protect his rights and that the respondent No.2 may be directed to return the same in original.

Counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents No.2 contends that the said documents are old and have been misplaced by him. He, however, undertakes to return the same in original as and when the same are traced by him.

In view of the above statement, made by learned counsel for the respective parties, the present petition is disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. Learned counsel for respondent No.2 shall, however, remain bound by his statement made hereinabove.
