1. The instant writ petition has been filed by the petitioner under Article 226 of the Constitution of India *inter alia seeking* a writ of certiorari for quashing the impugned notice/order dated 16.02.2021 (Annexure P-14) issued by respondent No.4 i.e. Recovery Officer wherein the petitioner was directed to appear and to deposit the requisite amount, else proceedings under Section 8-B to 8-G of the “Employees Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act 1952” will be initiated.
