The petitioner is alleging violation of the order dated 16.11.2016, passed by this Court, vide which, it was directed that respondent Nos. 2 and 4 shall not appoint anybody from outside the Sugar Mill. This order was directed to continue, vide order dated 14.11.2018.

Later on, the respondent-Sugar Mill moved an application and on 13.09.2019, the order dated 14.11.2018 was modified to the extent that Panipat Cooperative Sugar Mill Ltd. can proceed to fill up 129 posts of skilled and other categories during the crushing season.

Learned counsel for the petitioner relies upon two office orders dated 10.02.2021 to submit that some of the ex-employees the sugar mill have been adjusted on their giving undertaking that on yearly basis. The dispute raised by learned counsel for the petitioner is that they have been adjusted against permanent posts.

Be whatsoever, the petitioner has a remedy to challenge the said action in the pending writ petition as there is no violation of the orders

passed by this Court.

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of.

Rule stands discharged.

The petitioner is granted liberty to challenge the said order in accordance with law, if so advised.
