This petition has been filed seeking a writ of *mandamus* directing the respondents to consider the petitioner for appointment on the post of PGT Physics (Mewat), pursuant to Advt. No.4/2015 dated 28.06.2015.

2. Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has participated in the selection process and was shortlisted for interview on 11.01.2017. As per result declared for the post of PGT Physics (Mewat cadre) on 06.12.2018, the petitioner was not selected since he scored lesser marks than those of the last selected candidate in the general category. His result was produced before this Court in a sealed cover on 27.03.2019, which showed he had scored 99 marks, whereas marks scored by the last selected candidate in his category were 114. It is, therefore, submitted that the petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner was duly considered for the post in question.

3. In view of the submissions made by learned State counsel, it is apparent that the petitioner was considered for the post in question and was not selected since he failed to make the mark. Therefore, there is no merit in the petition.

4. Dismissed.
