Prayer is for grant of anticipatory bail in case having FIR No.7 dated 14.01.2023 registered under Sections 21(1) and 4 (1) Mines and Minerals Regulation of Development Act, 1957 and Section 379 IPC at Police Station Nangal, District Rupnagar.

On the last date of hearing, detailed order was passed by this Court whereby interim bail was granted to the petitioner with direction to join the investigation with the police.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that by virtue of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation with the police.

The State counsel on instructions from ASI Gurnaib Singh has not refuted the assertion made by the learned counsel for the petitioner and further apprised the Court that the recoveries are already effected in this case and the petitioner is not required by the police for further investigation and custodial interrogation.

In the light of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and order of interim bail dated 23.02.2023 is

hereby made absolute subject to the conditions as envisaged under Section 438 (2)
Cr.P.C.
