After arguing for sometime and apprehending adverse order, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he is not pressing the present petition any further but prays that the time granted by the Court below to the petitioner to deposit the amount as assessed in impugned order dated 19.01.2023 be extended.

With regard to the said argument, period of four months has already been given by the Court below vide order dated 19.01.2023, out of which period, two and a half months are still left and in case there is any difficulty in depositing the said assessed amount within the time frame granted by the trial Court, the petitioner will be at liberty to approach the Rent Controller for the extension of time, which application if filed, be decided by the Rent Controller in accordance with law after analyzing the difficulty put up by the petitioner and by giving due notice to the other side.

Petition stands disposed of in above terms.
