The petitioner has filed the present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of appropriate directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner and her family members, who are being threatened and harassed by respondent No.4, in collusion with respondents No.5 to 7.

A reply has been filed by way of an affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Dharamkot, District Moga on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

Learned State counsel submits that the enquiry has been conducted by the local police and it has been found that a civil dispute is pending between both the parties. Moreover, respondent No.4 has already been transferred from District Moga and there is no apprehension to the life and liberty of the

petitioner.

Learned State counsel has further assured the Court that in case any representation is received from the petitioner with regard to the threat to her life and liberty, the appropriate action shall be taken on the same, in accordance with law.

In view of the statement made by learned State counsel nothing survives in the present petition and is ordered to be disposed off, accordingly.
